YTU WiFi

YTU's WiFi network is for the benefit of all students. However certain restrictions have been put in place to ensure that the WiFi is safe and secure for all students and to prevent abuse.

1. Each WiFi password can only be tagged to 1 (ONE) device. Once you have tagged this 1 device, you cannot use this password on other devices. i.e. If you have accessed the YTU WiFi on your mobile phone, you may not use the same password to access the YTU WiFi on your notebook or tablet.
2. You may obtain a separate password for you other devices. However each password can only be used for that 1 (ONE) device. Each device needs to have its own password to access the YTU WiFi network.
3. Access to e-mail is best done through browsers. I.e. Firefox, Chrome, Edge or Safari. YTU's WiFi will not allow emails to be downloaded to certain mail apps on your mobile device.
